BYANG H. KATO: A BIBLIOGRAPHY

[Dr Christina Breman is the author of *The Association of Evangelicals in Africa: Its History, Organization, Members, Projects, External Relations, and Message* (Zoetermeer, Netherlands: Boekencentrum, 1996). Dr Breman compiled the following bibliography as part of her doctoral research, and has made it available to the *ACTEA Tools & Studies* series in order to facilitate wider distribution and ease of access. This is by far the most extensive bibliography of Byang Kato's writings compiled to date. It is available in substantially the same form in the book by Dr Breman referenced above.
